things. And certainly, I should think that is more serious unless I shot him in the head than merely disobeying a game warden any number of times. So that language is totally unreasonable, maybe ought to leave it in the bill. Then it might be enough to bring the whole thing down, but since I am going to have to go to an Executive Board meeting, I'm serving notice that this that I've talked about is an area of the bill that I have a great amount of concern about and if there is a legitimate purpose for this bill, this kind of stuff that I've talked about does not demonstrate that fact. The bill itself is a piece of harassment legislation unworthy of this Legislature. Senator Chizek is trying to help a group that he deals with. He is too intelligent to put something like this together on his own. As a matter of fact, if he were trying to write a comedy piece...

So what I am trying to get across is that he wouldn't make a blunder like this on purpose or by accident in trying to be very helpful to constituents. So I hope between now and Select File, because this kind of bad legislation will probably move, I hope he can persuade those who want this legislation, they ought to take that out. But they should know that even if it is taken out, I still am opposed to it.
