

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Hillman, record your presence, please. Senator Nelson, record your presence. Senator Labedz, Senator Firsch, the house is under call. We need Senator Chambers. Senator Ashford, please record your presence. We need Senators Elmer, Wesely, Rod Johnson. All members are present. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 336. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 336. Have you all voted? Record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 386-87 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 336 advances. We'll now go to LB 336A.

CLERK: Mr. President...

SPEAKER BAACK: I will raise the call. Please stay close to the Chamber though, we've about a half an hour till we recess for...or till we adjourn.

CLERK: Mr. President, 336A is a bill originally introduced by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.) I do have an amendment pending to the bill by Senator Kristensen. (The Kristensen amendment, AM2431, appears on page 387 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, and members of the body, after the committee amendments there was an increase in \$1,000 to the General Fund by the committee amendments and there was a slight increase in the other numbers but all less than 200 or 300 dollars to the appropriations bill. And, with that, this amendment just puts the A bill in line with what the committee amendments accomplished. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Robinson, do you wish to address the amendment?

SENATOR ROBINSON: It has to do with money, doesn't it?
