SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Anyone else wishing to address the amendment by Senator Beyer? Senator Beyer, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beyer's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Anyone wishing to speak to the advancement of LB 314, as amended? Seeing no one, Senator Hartnett, do you wish to close?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Just briefly, Mr. Speaker. I simply...it just simply brings us up to date with as related to bicycles, brings our code up and we really follow the national standard. So, with that, I would ask for the adoption...the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 314. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 314.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 314 advances. We'll now go to LB 275.

CLERK: LB 275 is a bill introduced by Senators Wehrbein and Rogers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 15 of 1991, referred to the Agriculture Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have Agriculture Committee amendments pending, Mr. President.
