And they will correct a drafting error and nothing in the amendments change the Dairy Industry Development Board power and duties which will commence only if the Federal Order 65, which most of you probably don't know what Federal Order 65 is, a promotion agency, if either of that is modified. I ask for the adoption.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Rogers. There is an amendment to the committee amendments.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to amend the committee amendments. The amendment is on page 159 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President, and members, this simply makes 1993 the date instead of 1992 because I introduced it a year ago, if you understood. So it's simply interjecting 1993 instead of 1992 under Senator Carson's amendment, Senator Carson Rogers' amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Wehrbein? Do you wish to close, Senator Wehrbein? We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. Now we are on the committee amendments, as amended. Anyone...anyone wishing to speak to those? Senator Rogers, do you wish to close?

SENATOR ROGERS: Waive closing.

SPEAKER BAACK: Closing has been waived. We will now vote on the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
