CLERK: LB 274 introduced by Senator Wehrbein. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 15 of last year, referred to the Agriculture Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Agriculture Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: To the Chair of the Agriculture Committee, Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, the committee amendments, the only thing that they do is designate that the office of the Governor shall be the agency under which the Climate Assessment Response Committee operates and the agency to which funds are appropriated for the committee functions and I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.
