SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'd be happy to consider that with you between now and Select.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: I'd like to talk to you about that aspect of it so...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thanks.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Anyone else wishing to discuss the advancement of LB 722? Seeing no one, Senator Schimek, do you wish to close?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: No, I would just ask for your indulgence and to move this and we will present that amendment that will tighten this language on Select File.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Schimek's closing on the advancement of LB 722. We'll now vote on that advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We're voting on the advancement of LB 722. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 722.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 722 advances. We will now go to LB 366.

CLERK: 366 was a bill introduced by Senator Rogers. (Title read.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, referred to the Agriculture Committee for public hearing, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rogers, for the committee amendments.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. Speaker, can I just go ahead and give a summary of the bill and then when I hit the amendments right along with them, is that permissible or not?
