SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, correct, that's right.

SENATOR NELSON: Boy, that's right on target. I certainly didn't want it so it was not published. I hate to say that, but I did not want that to happen. Thank you.

SENATOR HARTNETT: And that's the purpose.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Anyone else wishing to discuss the committee amendments? Senator Hartnett, do you wish to close on the committee amendments? He waives closing. We will now vote on the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The committee amendments are adopted. We'll now go to LB 415 as amended. Anyone wishing to speak to the advancement of LB 415? Seeing no one, Senator Peterson, do you wish to close?
