SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Anyone wishing to discuss the resolution? Seeing no one, Senator Abboud, do you wish to close? We will now proceed to vote on LR 231. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on LR 231. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of 231.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 231 is adopted. We will now proceed to Item 6, the leftover consent calendar bills from yesterday. We have LB 270.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 270 was a bill introduced by Senator Elmer. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 15 of last year, referred to Natural Resources, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Natural Resources Committee.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, the committee amendments are very simple. They simply change some dates to implement the program, just simply changing some dates. Move for the adoption of the amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will vote on the committee amendments to LB 270. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.
