SPEAKER BAACK: LB 226A advances. I would like to introduce a guest of Senator Robinson. It is Kurt Olsen from Waterloo. He actually is from Senator Beyer's district. He is under the south balcony. Would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you for being with us. We will now go to the special order bill, LB 1013.

CLERK: LB 1013, Mr. President, introduced by Senators Warner, Baack, Hefner and Lowell Johnson. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by Revenue Committee, Mr. President. (See AM2482 on page 467 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall, Chair of the Revenue Committee.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. The bill, 1013, was introduced to make amendments and changes necessary to LB 627 that was introduced last year also by Senator Warner and I think the same cosponsors who were on it. The committee amendments really only do a couple of things. We change, in Section 19, which is a penalty section for gasohol provisions, we changed the date which was currently listed in the bill as July 1, 1992, to January 1 of 1993. This is to allow the industry and the department to work out some details; and then the only other thing we do in the committee amendments is deal with renumbering of some sections that had to be done because of a drafting error. That is really all the committee amendments do. I appreciate the fact that the Speaker has given this bill the priority that he has. It is something that needs to be done as soon as possible. Hopefully, we can by expediting the bill off of General File and asking for that to take place, we will be able to hopefully pass it prior to February 1, which would allow...actually save us a lot of money, and I will let Senator Warner explain that in the introduction of the bill, itself. But the committee amendments are very simple and are only technical in nature. I would urge their adoption.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will vote on the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 1013, have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
