

January 27, 1992 LB 718

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 500-01 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. Members, please stay close to the Chamber so we can conduct business. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to amend. Senator Schmit, I have AM2402 in front of me. (Schmit amendment, AM2402, appears on pages 501-03 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members, I would like to offer an amendment to LB 718. The first amendment is AM2402, and I believe you have a copy on your desk. It is...it merely contains technical changes. And I have visited with Mr. Winston, because Senator Schellpeper is not here, we've gone over the amendment and there is nothing hidden in that amendment, but it requires that these changes be made based upon the recommendation of the bill drafters, and therefore I would move for the adoption of this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we will now proceed. Is there any debate on the amendment offered by Senator Schmit? Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I just...I need to ask Senator Schmit a question, if I can. The amendment you're speaking of, I didn't hear, is this the funding amendment for this bill?

SENATOR SCHMIT: No.

SENATOR MOORE: No, then that's the next one. Okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: Question of Senator Schmit, please. Is this just a little...I didn't get much of a definition of the amendment, a technical one discovered by bill dra...Could you help me out a little bit on what it does, or if it's an "a", "and", or "the", the wrong section, or something.
