

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion carries, we cease debate and I will recognize Senator Schmit for closing on the bill.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Madam Chairman, I believe the bill has been adequately explained and again I want to say that I think that as we move forward we will have additional opportunities to enhance banking legislation during this session of the Legislature. I hope that the body will advance the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schmit. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 470. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 470 is advanced. I would now like to direct the senators attention to the area under the north balcony.
