constitutes a public area under those circumstances, because technically, I suppose in a sense that's a nonpublic area, because there's a sign that says employees only. But...but it seldom is observed as a practical matter. And what constitutes this public area, or how is it designated? It's more of a question of how do peop...what individual business person, what...what do they need to do to protect themselves not to be in violation? Is it a simple sign that says employees only, even though it's not particularly observed sufficient to be a nonpublic area?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Warner, I think that's a very good question, and my answer would be that the sign isn't enough. If there is access to that area by the public in general, then I would...I would say that that is an area open to the general public and it would fall under the provisions of this section of the bill. It might be that the language needs to be tighter there. I...I don't know, I'll have to think about that. But in this case I don't think a sign saying that it's employees only is going to do it, unless...because the practice in this case is that it is, indeed, open to the general public and to minors in particular.
