SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam President, I did get in late. I just want to say I support this. I think it's worthwhile from a fair board standpoint and that's really all I wanted to say.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to the amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Schellpeper? Closing is waived. We will now vote on the Schellpeper amendment to LB 398. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Schellpeper amendment? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

Mr. Clerk 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Schellpeper's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 398 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've all heard the motion to advance LB 398. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 398 is advanced. LB 523.

CLERK: Madam President, 523, the first item, Senator Will, are E & R amendments, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 523.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.
