SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I need to ask you more questions.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No, I'm just using additional questions because I think it's a case by case examination and thus case by case depends on the facts and if you only have superficial facts, I need to fill in with my facts and so that's the reason of not being coy with you, is that I don't think that you take those superficial facts.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay, Senator Kristensen, thank you, Senator Kristensen. You've answered exactly what I wanted you to do and that is to ask me more questions. And the fact is, this statute...remember this is what is deciding it for everybody, not just for those with living wills. This statute requires a situation, for example, like reasonably available. Are these individuals reasonably available? Now guess who makes money if there is a dispute? The lawyers. It goes to court. If there is a dispute as to how that is interpreted, we go to litigation. And that, as we've just heard, Senator Beutler says I don't know if it's reasonably available and I concur with Senator Beutler. I don't know if it's reasonably available either. And we could go through with what Senator Kristensen has talked about and I could go through and give you all those facts, fill in that skeleton, flush it out a little bit and give you all the facts that Senator Kristensen needs to decide and I will virtually assure you that Senators Beutler, Kristensen, Ashford, Senator Landis is a lawyer, Senator Chambers, we could all probably come with five different interpretations of that and those are people
