PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 21 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 21. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 21 is advanced. LB 677.

CLERK: LB 677, Senator, I have E & R amendments pending, first of all.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 677.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Wesely would move to amend. The amendment is on page 582 of the Journal. (See AM2614.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Madam President and members, this amendment was brought primarily from E & R to clean up some language and also it strikes a section that had been previously inserted in another bill that was passed last year. It is no longer necessary, so Section 34 is deleted, and some wording changes are incorporated that improved the language of the bill. With that, I would move for the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Wesely amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Wesely amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.
