SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I think that the resolution that was introduced that's on page 605 simply recognizes Creighton University School of Medicine. It was kind of a dream of John A. Creighton to form something to help the great State of Nebraska and I think that over the years Creighton University School of Medicine has provided physicians for this state and all the states of this great nation. And I think that it has carried on research, especially, in lots of fields, especially in cancer research which, I think, is very, very important for the health of the state. And it's added a lot to the state and to Omaha, Nebraska. With that, I would ask the body to adopt this resolution.
