So that amendment is simply being resubmitted today and I don't think that Senator Rogers or Senator Schmit have any objection to it. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Pirsch, did you wish to speak to the amendment?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes, I almost feel like I should speak since I raised the question that caused some consternation on the floor and I apologize to Senator Beutler. And this is a good amendment, and it was in good form, and I move that or I would like to see it returned to Select File to be attached.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Anyone else wishing to speak to the motion to return to Select File? Seeing no one, do you wish to close on your motion, Senator Beutler? We will now vote on the motion to return LB 312 to Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is returned. We will now proceed to the amendment. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, I would simply move the adoption of the amendment, and thank the body for the indulgence, and I am sorry for the misstep.
