SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...would be wrong.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Lindsay, you are next.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I'd yield my time to Senator Will.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. Since taking up the Hall amendment, I have learned that Senator Hall and Senator Beutler have agreed that on his next amendment, Senator Hall was going to allow Senator Beutler to substitute an amendment. So rather than risk Senator Hall's amendment that we are on currently at this point, I would ask unanimous consent to pass over this amendment, take up the next amendment, and allow Senator Beutler to substitute his amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. We will go to the Beutler amendment.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, I have your amendment that reads, "Strike beginning with the word 'and' in line 18, page 22, through Section 39-669.18 in line 20 on page 22."

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I hope you will pay attention to this particular amendment because it deals with a section of the bill which I think is particularly dubious in terms of whether we should be including it as part of this measure. I am generally, to give you my position, I am generally supportive of most of the provisions of the bill. However, if you would turn to page 22 of the bill and orient yourself to that particular section, it will be the subject of two or three amendments unless there is some compromise on it earlier, I am sure. But this particular part of the bill doesn't deal with drunk driving at all, doesn't deal with drunk driving at all. What it says is that it is unlawful for any person under 21 years of age to operate or be in the actual physical control of a motor vehicle under certain conditions, and those conditions are conditions that indicate that some alcohol has been imbibed but under no circumstances would anyone assert that there is any impairment under those
