SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...sure, which lines does it take out?

SENATOR BEUTLER: It strikes beginning with "and" in line 18 on page 22, and ending with 39-669.18 on line 20 on page 22. It just strikes the license revocation provision.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And it goes to line 23?

SENATOR BEUTLER: To line 20, to line 20, I am sorry.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: At the end of 39-669...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: 669.18.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, so it still leaves in there "the lesser included offense of driving while intoxicated," that last sentence there?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, it does.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, I would urge the body to defeat this amendment to the amendment. I find the policy, you need to make it consistent. The other policy would be let's do away with making it illegal for minors underage to possess alcohol and make the policy consistent. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Chambers, on the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I agree with Senator Beutler's amendment, but I don't think it goes far enough. However, that is not what we are discussing now and I am going to deal with his amendment. But I want to get the copy of the bill and ask Senator Kristensen a question or two.
