SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would be foolish to tell you they didn't.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, does .02 concentration of alcohol place one under the influence of alcohol?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Not under our current law, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If the philosophy of this bill is to deal with those who are under the influence of alcohol, what you are doing to minors is inconsistent with that provision of the bill, isn't it?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, now these people who are under the influence are hazards to the health and safety of all persons using the highways is what the following language says, on page 27. Do you agree that persons under the influence are a hazard to the health and safety of all persons using the highways? Do you agree with that?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.
