SPEAKER BAACK: We will proceed to Item 5 on the agenda, legislative resolutions, and LR 228 by Senator Schrock.

CLERK: Mr. President, 228 by Senator Schrock, found on page 383 of the Journal. Would you like me to read the resolution, Senator, or...okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Doesn't matter.

CLERK: All right...asking that the Legislature congratulate Mr. Blake Johnson for being selected as the American Star Farmer.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, it is indeed an honor for me to have an American Star Farmer in my legislative district. Being chosen American Star Farmer was a big accomplishment by Blake Johnson. Blake, the son of Mr. and Mrs. William Johnson of Holdrege, received the National FFA's highest award last November. This was no small achievement when you consider the fact that there are 382,000 national members of the National Farmers...or the...or the Future Farmers of America. Blake is a student at the University of Nebraska where he majors in agricultural economics with a farm and ranch management option. In addition to working on his college degree, he managed to obtain his own financing to buy a tract of land where he raises crops and cattle. Blake and his parents are visiting us this morning. I hope you will join me in voting for this legislative resolution. The last American Star Farmer the State of Nebraska had was in 1960 and he is only the fourth American Star Farmer from Nebraska.
