SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam Speaker, members, I support this amendment by Senator Hartnett. As I understand it it's a "may", it's not a "shall also", so it still allows the SID to maintain control, but it does allow the landowner, in this case, to seek some degree of understanding. And if all are agreeable, they could do it. But it still keeps the authority in the SID.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Does anyone else wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Hartnett? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Hartnett amendment to LB 764. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 764 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 764. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 764 is advanced. Before we proceed, I'd like to call the senators attention to the south balcony. Special guests today of Senator Crosby are 75 students from the Cathedral of the Risen Christ in Lincoln and their sponsor. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Chamber today. Thank you. We'll proceed with Select File, LB 301. We are going to pass over that. We'll now proceed with LB 948.

CLERK: LB 948, Senator, I have E & R amendments pending first of all.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 948.
