

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: The Legislature has the final control over what happens.

SENATOR WESELY: That is all I need to know. Thank you very much. I withdraw the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Proceed with Final Reading.

CLERK: Read LR 9CA on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 9CA pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 726-27 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 7 nays, 8 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LR 9CA passes. The refreshments being handed out by the Pages are in honor of Senator Morrissey's birthday on Sunday, February 9th, and they are courtesy of the senator. Congratulations. We will now proceed with General File, Consent Calendar, LB 921.

CLERK: Madam President, if I may, right before that, just one item, the Banking Committee gives notice of confirmation hearing, signed by Senator Landis as Chair of the committee.

LB 921 on General File was introduced by Speaker Baack. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 8 of this year, referred to Education Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.
