

February 7, 1992 LB 369, 928, 1247

Committee conducted a number of meetings and hearings with the League of Municipalities to try and solve this problem and, in fact, a compromise has been reached on this issue, at least we hope it has been reached. And that compromise is placed in LB 1247, which is going to be heard by the Urban Affairs Committee next Tuesday, I believe, and the idea was, the committee discussed this issue, was to send this bill to the floor to serve as a vehicle and, basically, have a public hearing on LB 1247, get public comment, and find out if, in fact, the compromise that has been worked out between the committee and the League is, in fact, acceptable to the public. And if it is, then we will simply amend LB 369, as it sits on Select File, to incorporate the changes that have been worked out in LB 1247. This bill, basically, is a shell that is going to be used later to incorporate those changes, but the committee thought, because of the fact that timing is so critical this session, to address this issue, we needed at least to move this bill out and get it on the floor, and discuss this issue at a later date when we offer the compromise amendment. So I would simply ask the body to move the bill today with the understanding that an amendment will probably be offered on Select File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Johnson. Does anyone wish to address this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 369. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to advance LB 369? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the advancement of 369.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 369 is advanced. LB 928.

CLERK: Madam President, 928 was a bill introduced by Senator Will. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred to Urban Affairs, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President and members of the body, LB 928 is a bill that relates to the issuance of handicapped parking permits. We rewrote the handicapped parking permit statutes a couple of years ago, and one of the provisions that was included
