

February 7, 1992 LB 982, 982A, 1004

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 982.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 982 is advanced. LB 982A.

CLERK: Madam President, 982A introduced by Senator Conway. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. LB 992A (sic) which was brought to me after we introduced the bill for \$1,820 to be directed to the state treasurer to provide for the programming and any miscellaneous changes that go in the treasurer's department. There is probably offsetting increases to the General Fund by virtue of the interest accumulations and moving the cash flow benefit, but that would accrue to the General Fund and, therefore, the Fiscal felt that the state treasurer's office should get or have an A bill for the \$1,820 for the specific programming that would accrue to that department. The bottom line is that there is probably an actual gain in the exchange, but the treasurer, in and of itself, in that department needs \$1,820 to reprogram for the one year instead of two. So it is \$1,820.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 982A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the motion to advance LB 982A? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 982A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 982A is advanced. LB 1004.

CLERK: LB 1004 introduced by Senators Landis and Hall. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 9, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.
