PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: A question of Senator Nelson if she would respond, please.

SENATOR NELSON: Certainly.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Nelson, and my question is with...is in regard to the \$50 penalty on page 3 of the bill. Do you believe this to be necessary?

SENATOR NELSON: I had that same question that we had in another bill, hearing in front of the Retirement Committee. In fact, I think it was \$10 and I do stand to be corrected on that...prior, and the reason of it is it was just ignored and the retirement systems was having too much difficulty in getting the information. It is primarily from the smaller school systems so I do say that it is a fairly heavy penalty but maybe that's the only way that they can get it implemented and it is in there for a purpose.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Nelson. I have some concerns over putting a fine in a bill of this type and we'll be looking forward to conversations with you between now and Select File.

SENATOR NELSON: Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Does anyone else wish to address this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Nelson? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the motion to advance LB 934. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on LB 934? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on advancement of LB 934

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 934 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Your Committee on Government whose Chair is Senator Conway to whom was referred LB 988
