about head injuries, the newsletters and so on that we get from the support groups, and the people at Madonna, and at Immanuel in Omaha, and other places, we have learned so much about head injury that we didn't know before. And so I think that the register, and this kind of thing gives us records and information that will help other people as they come along, plus the fact it helps those who are...who have the head injuries. Every head injury is different, but so many things pour into the information and the picture that you get of a head injury. So I'm, as I say, going to support the bill, and I hope all of you will and get it moving along. And I thank Senator Lynch for getting it onto General File for us. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Senator Robinson, you're next.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. President, members of the body, I have some questions I'd like to ask Senator Lynch, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Who gets the...what do they do, the hospitals get a form and they complete it, or just how does the information get to Lincoln?

SENATOR LYNCH: The information would be provided, as I pointed out in my opening, within certain days of your provider, within 30 days, provider, hospital, or a physician. It will come to the Department of Health. There will be forms that will be developed by the Department of Health based on the language of the bill, so the physicians, the doctors, the psychologists, and all the rest will simply have the form available for this reporting purposes. So they won't have to make up and make it up as they go along.
