SENATOR WARNER: Motion pending is the adoption of the Baack amendment to the committee amendment. Those in favor vote aye. Excuse me. Ask for call of the house?

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: I'm sorry, I didn't catch that. Call of the house has been requested. Those in support of call of the house vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is carried, the house is under call. Members, please return to your desks, check in for call of the house. Would you please check in. The house is under call. Senator Lindsay, Senator Landis, Senator Beutler, Senator Peterson, Senator Cudaback. Senator Robinson, would you punch in, please. Senator Haberman. Senator Horgan, Senator Lynch, return and check in. Senator Horgan, return to the Chamber, please. Senator Baack, Senator Horgan is the only one...he's here. There's been a request to have a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 780 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion is carried, the amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments on the desk? Yeah, raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have other amendments. The next I have is by Senator Hall. Senator, I have his AM2665, that's printed on 616.

SENATOR WARNER: Is someone prepared to take it? Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I'd like to pass over the rest of the Hall amendments at this time.

SENATOR WARNER: Is there objection? If not, so ordered.
