Further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Will, you have the next amendment, Senator. AM2668.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I'd like to pass over that amendment, too.

CLERK: Senator, just so you and I are in...when you say pass over, you want it retained, not withdrawn. Is that correct?

SENATOR WILL: Yes.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I'd ask to withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, Senator Chambers, who is excused until he arrives.

SENATOR WARNER: Anyone wish to take...otherwise, we'll pass over the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, second amendment from Senator Chambers.

SENATOR WARNER: Anyone wish to take the amendment? If not, it will be passed over.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Ashford would move to amend. He's also excused until he arrives.
