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do so, which I would do, and then there would have to be an amendment then that the body would say are we going to provide funding for it, are we going to make it so that only those that can afford it can. And I think that's a policy question that has to be answered in two factors, two forums. Number one is this amendment, and number two, then the funding. Senator Withem, did you need more time? Or, I'd like to go ahead one step further and talk about funding just for a second. Even the Kristensen amendment, no one has talked about funding yet, because we haven't agreed to the...it's not the Kristensen amendment, it's the committee amendments. We have not agreed with the committee amendments yet, so no one has talked about funding, how much is it going to cost. We're making policy decisions here. Once the committee amendments are agreed to then the fiscal office will give it a fiscal impact, we'll say, oh, by the way, it's going to cost X number of dollars. And then we'll be looking at that aspect to see if we want to do the policy, knowing the fiscal impact of it. This is no different. We want to decide are we going to do the policy of helping treatment on first time offenders, or those that have never received treatment, and once we've established...put this within the committee amendments then the fiscal staff will give the Legislature, once it's agreed to, they'll say, hey, you've agreed to this policywise, here's what it's going to cost. And on Select File, or later on General File, if it continues on, but particularly on Select File then we make the second policy...

SENATOR WARNER: One minute.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: ...decision, are we going to pay the cost of the policy. That's as clear as I can make the option to the body. I appreciate Senator Withem's questions very much.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Bernard-Stevens, if I could just have a little dialogue with you, and...so I make sure I know what this does and the body as well. We're dealing here in the area of what we call the zero tolerance, is that...is that your impression for the...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yes.
