CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are now on the advancement of LB 306. Anyone wishing to speak to the advancement of LB 306? Seeing no one, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close on the advancement?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I think the discussion has been very thorough. I think there have been lots of good questions asked. Hopefully, most of the answers have been given. But I do understand that there may be suggestions in a number of different areas, from a number of different people. And what I pledge to you to do is to send around a letter, just as soon as we're done with this General File debate. And I'm going to invite you to send to me whatever written comments you want dealt with on 306, and I will set up a meeting for senators to talk about those concerns, and we will have every opportunity to deal with the peripheral kinds of questions. And I think most of the questions are, as I understand the conversation today, peripheral kinds of things. You...it sounds to me like there are a number of people who want to be sure that we're not going beyond what we say we're doing in an unintentional sort of way, and that's fine. So I want to keep the process open. I want to get it to where everybody is comfortable that the concept does what we all think it's going to do. And, to that end, I would ask for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard Senator Beutler's closing on the advancement of LB 306. We'll now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 306. Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I'd ask for a call of the house and take call-in votes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Call of the house has been requested. We will...All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
