SENATOR ROBINSON: Would you ever see it be self-sustaining? Or do you see...

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Self-sustaining (interruption).

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...it under General File money forever and forever?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Well, no, sir, I don't see that it will probably be self-sustaining at any point.

SENATOR ROBINSON: So you're saying...what are you saying then, that it will be around \$150,000 for like on '93-94, or will it be higher than that as you have it in '91-92...or, excuse me, '92-93?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Well, Senator, that would be up to this Legislature, obviously, through the appropriations process to how much you and the Appropriations Committee would want to put in this fund if the bill does pass this year.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Any other discussion on the advancement of LB 338A? Seeing none, Senator Johnson, do you wish to close?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: I think I've covered most of what I wanted to say, that this was in...this A bill is in response to Senator Moore's inquiries on how the program might be established if, in fact, we pass the authorizing legislation. So I would move for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Rod Johnson's closing on the advancement of LB 338A. We will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.
