

February 13, 1992 LB 275, 757, 758, 922A

Under the south balcony, we have Stan Haas from Scottsbluff. Would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Mr. Clerk, LB 922A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, 922A was introduced by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on February 11th, placed directly on General File.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this is the A bill for 922, the multicultural bill. And the bulk of the amount will go to create a full-time staff position and a one-half time secretarial position to help carry out the provisions of the bill. And if you look at the fiscal note, and turn to the second page, you will see the specific duties that are contemplated for the professional staff meeting. As Senator Withem pointed out, we intend to have a meeting with representatives of the Department of Education and all others who might be interested in this bill to see exactly how they propose to carry out the requirements of the bill. But the purpose of this A bill, at this point, is to provide money for the full-time staff person, the one-half time secretarial person, to carry out the requirements of the bill as placed on the Department of the Education. So I'm asking that it be advanced to E & R.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any other discussion on the advancement of LB 922A? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 922A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 922A advances. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 757 and LB 758. We will now proceed to Select File, LB 275.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 275, I do have E & R amendments.
