

February 13, 1992 LB 275

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 275.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 275. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment from Senator Wehrbein. That amendment is found on page 786 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, and members, as I have explained before, this is a very technical bill for the dairy industry on the checkoff. It simply does change the administration to confirm that it's at a state level and terms of checkoff money raised by the dairy industry. So, in essence, for those of you listening, the magic word can be considered "cash". These are technical amendments to this bill as they were presented on General File, simply having gone through the bill word by word, and changing the wording in appropriate places. It does not change the original intent of the bill at all, it simply is clarifying language and I would urge adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Anyone wishing to speak to the amendment by Senator Wehrbein? Seeing no one, do you wish to close, Senator Wehrbein? Waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment by Senator Wehrbein. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER BAACK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 275 to E & R for engrossment.
