SPEAKER BAACK: You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 706. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Ashford would move to amend the bill. (See FA266 on page 848 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I have one amendment. It has two parts. The first part, this adds to the membership of this Historic Preservation Task Force a member of a Nebraska Indian tribe. This issue was brought to me by the Native American rights group which brought my attention to the fact that a member of a Nebraska Indian tribe was not included on the list of individuals to be considered for membership on this Historic Preservation Task Force. I appreciate the group bringing me that request and this amendment, first of all, adds to membership, or adds a member of a Nebraska Indian tribe as a potential member of this group. Secondly, there is a technical amendment which in subparagraph (6) of Section 3, the wording is current or present membership in a local historic preservation body as a potential member of the task force. It was intended to be current or past membership in a local historic preservation body as a potential member for the task force. So this amendment, one, adds for consideration for membership in this group the member of an Indian tribe, and then makes that technical revision. With that, I would move the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion of the amendment, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. President and members of the body, I just want to rise in support of this amendment and say that I think that the Native American tribe should definitely be included in the membership on this task force. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Mr. Clerk, an announcement.
