SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you. Anyone else wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Ashford. Seeing no on, Senator Ashford, do you wish to close?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Just very briefly, Mr. Speaker. Obviously, it was not intended to preclude from this task force membership of any person who supports the repatriation and reburial of human skeletal remains and burial goods which have been disinterred at any time, so just to make sure that that is our intent here clearly in the record. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Ashford. We will now vote on the amendment offered by Senator Ashford. All those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Senator Ashford, have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Ashford's amendment.
