Hall's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Before we go to the next item, I would like to introduce some guests of Senator Wehrbein. We have 10 senior students in Government from Lourdes Central Catholic Schools in Nebraska City with their superintendent. Would you folks please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature.
