PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schmit. Does anyone wish to speak to this motion? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to withdraw. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the withdrawal of LB 1228.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is approved. We will now proceed with Item 7 on the agenda, LR 239.

CLERK: LR 239, Madam President, offered by Senator Schmit, found on page 850 of the Journal, asks the Legislature to declare and designate Saunders County the Soybean Capital of Nebraska.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Madam President and members, Saunders County has for the past six years led the state in soybean production. It is becoming a well-known area for livestock feeding, and it also utilizes a lot of soybeans in the cracking and the grinding and crushing industry. They have, of course, many acres of soybeans and are, I believe, historically in the category of number one in soybean production and have asked me to introduce this resolution in recognition of that achievement. They have for the past six years, as I said, been number one and have almost every year raised more than 4 million bushels of soybeans, and I ask for your approval of the resolution.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schmit. Does anyone wish to speak to this resolution? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to adopt LR 239. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
