filed on LB 933 would have simply required that a sign had a notice on it which specified what the fine is for parking in handicapped spaces. I think often people don't realize what the fine is. This would have either involved printing or making of new signs, or devising some kind of a sticker program. Neither of these amendments really had enough discussion, although I testified and talked about them in the committee hearing. So what I would like to do is just call your attention to these statutes, and say that I would like to pursue them and withdraw both of these amendments at this time. Thank you.
