PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Cudaback.

I don't know what the situation will be by then, but one should not...no citizen should get the impression that they should throw the forms away because this is to provide them more time to fill them out, consult with their appropriate professional people they consult with and then maybe there may be legislation that would have some impact on it as well, but it's to allow for all those things.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I think they do understand that, but there was a question whether it had to be on an individual basis or whether it could be a blanket policy, but if we call our assessors and tell them it can be on a...
