for purposes other than actual value. Second thing that it does, it's terminology changes, number one. The second thing that it does is there was an incorrect date, we put in 1993 where it was supposed to be 1992. It was 1992 in other spots, we just...it was a drafting error we caught. And then all we do is we...there is, thirdly, there is an additional harmonizing section on the income tax return increase in the redistribution formula that had to be included to make sure that that was listed properly in the bill. I would, no matter where you are on the committee amendments or any of the other issues in the bill, I would urge that you adopt this very technical amendment to it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the Hall amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
