PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Landis. We will now vote on the Withem amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Withem amendment? Have you all voted?

SENATOR HALL: Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Yes, Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Could I ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote?

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a call of the house. All of those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB..or LR 243. Senator Lamb, Senator Landis, Senator Beutler, please check in. Senator Chambers and Senator Peterson. While we are waiting for the other senators to return, I'd like to call your attention to the area under the north balcony. Special guest of Senator Pirsch today is Dennis Moore, a constituent from District 10. Welcome to the Legislature today. We will proceed with a roll call vote on the Withem amendment to the committee amendments on LB 1120, and this requires a simple majority. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.
