SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Pirsch...

SENATOR HABERMAN: It does exclude all of your favorite organizations and all organizations that are excluded from paying tax at the present time.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes. Your 501C3, nonprofit.

SENATOR HABERMAN: That is correct. Now beings as all of those people are excluded, are you inclined to support the bill?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Well I guess I'm wondering what's left that is going to raise \$2 million?

SENATOR HABERMAN: That's what is left.

SENATOR PIRSCH: That's my question.
