

Freer, the Rural Health Advisory Commission; Dr. Michael Haller, same commission; Faye Schellpeper, the same commission; Dr. Michael Sitorius, same commission; and Roger Wells, also the Rural Health Advisory Commission. And we also considered two appointments to the Child Abuse Prevention Board, Gay Angel McTate and Nancy Nielsen. The committee, on a vote of 5-0-2, 2 absent, recommended that these appointments be approved and we now submit that report to the body. I move for their adoption.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone wish to speak to this confirmation report? Seeing none, we will now vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the confirmation report, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The report is adopted. Item 6 on the agenda, legislative resolutions. LR 233.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, LR 233 was introduced by Senators Baack, Rogers, Coordsen and Byars and it's found on page 474 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Just one minute, I'm not prepared yet. Yes, Madam President, and colleagues, in these...the resolutions, the next four resolutions are all introduced in conjunction with the observance of Statehood Day this weekend here in Lincoln. And these are the people who were voted to receive various awards on Statehood Day which...and I think the awards are going to be presented this Friday. And this one...the first one is for Willard Waldo and he is a former State Senator and he has been nominated to receive the Wagonmaster Award. And I would urge the body to adopt this resolution.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Madam Chairman and body, I stand up to give the same message that Speaker Baack gave. I've known Senator Waldo, Willard Waldo, Waldo Farms, whatever you want to call it. I've been involved with Willard for years in the Nebraska Pork Producers and I just urge for your adoption of this resolution.
