PRESIDENT MOUL: Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, this is the final resolution in the series of resolutions for Statehood Day this weekend. This one is to honor Archbishop Daniel Sheehan. He has been the Archbishop in Omaha for over 22 years. He was born and raised in the same diocese where he has been the Archbishop. He has been involved in a number of...a number of activities in public service and he has been nominated to receive the Pioneer Award for Nebraskaland Days. Thank you. I urge adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. Does anyone wish to speak to this resolution? Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam Speaker, and thank you, Senator Baack, for presenting this resolution. I voted for all of them, of course, but I would like to just especially speak and thank the Nebraskaland group for...organization for offering this award to Archbishop Daniel Sheehan, a native, a Nebraskan who has distinguished himself in the Catholic Church and, actually, he is a leader and exemplifies our feelings of Catholics all across all three dioceses, having to do with education, the involvement of laity in the church. And I just thank you very much for bringing this and I think that it's a real tribute to Catholicism, to Catholic education and to these men and women in our church who lead the way for us and who educate our children and lead us in our spiritual life. Thank you.
