SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the advancement of LB 734A. Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Hall? Waives closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 734A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 734A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 734A advances. We will now proceed to Item 8 on the agenda, Final Reading. Senators, please take your seats so we can start Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 907.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 907 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 907 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1031-32 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 907 passes. We will now go to LB 921.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 921 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 921 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1032-33 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 921 passes. We will now proceed to Item 9 on the agenda, General File. Items for the record first, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, very quickly, amendments to be printed by
