SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the portion of the amendment, we are voting on Section 183, I think, of the amendment because it has been divided. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the first portion of the amendment, Section 183 of the amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Mr. Speaker, I'd like a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER BAACK: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Members, please record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Rasmussen, would you record your presence, please. We're looking for Senators Labedz, Chizek, Chambers, Lynch and Senator Schmit.

SENATOR ASHFORD: In regular order.

SPEAKER BAACK: Regular order roll call has been requested. Looking for Senators Chizek, Labedz, Chambers, Lynch and Schmit. We're looking for Senators Labedz and Chizek. We now need Senator Chizek. Senator Ashford, we cannot locate Senator Chizek. Can we go ahead? Mr. Clerk, roll call in regular order. Please keep your conversations down so the Clerk may hear your responses. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1048-49 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised. We will now proceed to the other part of the amendment. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I would ask for a further division of the remaining portion of the amendment and that would be, I think we've identified the numbers, Section 176 through 182 I believe, pull out for separate treatment the sales tax for service portion of the amendment.
