SENATOR CONWAY: Time.

SENATOR WARNER: ...purposes of our revenue for the state, sometime recognize as the economy moves towards services that there is also a need...

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, is Senator Ashford in the body at the moment? Yeah, there he is. I just have a question for you, Senator Ashford, because I'm not so sure how many of us really know what it is we are voting on at the moment. And I am working from your...your revised document here where you have one, .1, .2, .3 and then under .3 you have an explanation of the specific services. Is that correct?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes.

SENATOR WITHEM: That was the full amendment. We have already adopted .2 under your explanation. Is that correct?

SENATOR ASHFORD: That's correct.

SENATOR WITHEM: That's the division. So, in essence, now what we're dealing with is the policy choice that is before us, if we adopt your amendment, is we replace your laundry list of services with that, for that which is currently in the...

SENATOR ASHFORD: That's correct.

SENATOR WITHEM: ...bill, .1, and .2 we change what is currently in 1120 which is a repeal on personal property tax with an insertion of taxing personal property?
