I'm at with this amendment. But it...what it does, it raises the one-half cent sales collection fee. It puts a tax on personal residential services on just a few of them, and it puts a tax on other business taxes on services and also on interstate long distance. So you can see the list that's there. Now, we'll have to find some additional funding, but this will put back what Senator Ashford thought was going to be coming out of the bill. With that, I would move the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Before we proceed to the vote, you heard Senator Schellpeper's closing, I will remind the body that this amendment has been divided and we're voting on everything except for Section 2 of the amendment. Everything else is in. The only thing that's out is Section 2. We're voting on all the remaining sections of the bill. Yes, Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Now, the...what we're voting on, Section 2 has already been approved, as I understand it.

SPEAKER BAACK: No, Section 2 has not been approved.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: You're right. You're right. So don't look at the sheet that I passed out because those are just numbers. What we're talking about is what's in the actual amendment. And Section 2, in the amendment, lists these figures on services. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we are...we are voting on everything in the amendment except for Section 2.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Not...and not breeding livestock.

SPEAKER BAACK: That's right, that's Section 2, if I understand it right. Okay, we will proceed to vote on the amendment offered by...the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Schellpeper on the portion that we're voting on. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record vote has been requested. A record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
