SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I will withdraw that.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I believe, Senator Ashford, you have another amendment to your amendment now, Senator. That's where we go. This is the amendment that would amend AM3109. On page 232, line 8, insert the word "new" before "business" and before "farm".

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Briefly, and then I'm going to withdraw this amendment. But, if I might, what we have just done with that vote is, and I assume most of you know this, but Senator Moore just asked, are we...with that vote, did we do away with the effort to get LB 1063 into 1120? And we did. So we're back to 1120 as it is. That's my understanding, if that...if my amendment is withdrawn. Is that correct, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I'm sorry, Senator.

SENATOR ASHFORD: If this...if I withdraw this amendment, then we're back to 1120 as it...as it stood before I offered my amendment originally this morning. Or it has been amended, I'm sorry.

CLERK: Right.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Okay, so we're back to 1120 as amended but the amendment that I offered, if I withdraw this, would be...would no longer be there. Is that correct?

CLERK: Senator, I really am not sure I understand. We have AM3...

SENATOR ASHFORD: I'm not withdrawing...I'm just going to withdraw this part of the amendment, but I just was wondering what the status of the bill would be, 1120, if I withdraw this amendment.
